



Rubbish and dustbins

We don't have doorstep rubbish collection here but we do have massive communal bins just up the road (up the drive and keep going for 50 yds).

There are plenty of bin liners under the sink for all the bins; when you have a full one just take it up the road and dump it. The green bins are for anything plastic or paper and packaging and cans, the brown ones are for anything unrecyclable - nappy liners, broken plates, old pianos and so on.

Glass bottles go in any of the many glass recycling containers in supermarket car parks and villages etc. If you don't mind us seeing how much you drink just put them in the container by the big barn and we'll take them for you.

Food waste, if you want to recycle it can go in our compost bin in the garden - there is a food waste container under the sink that you can use. The compost bin is across the garden - half left as you go out the back door and about 75 yards across the lawn.
